## **Read Matthew 17:14-23**

NB verse 21 is absent from most modern translations since it is not found in the earliest manuscripts. In the King James version it is included as a footnote and reads: "But this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting."

- 1. What is the context of this incident? What has just occurred?
- 2. Why might the disciples have been a little embarrassed?
- 3. What is the significance of Jesus' words in vv22-23, straight after the incident of vv14-20?
- 4. Have you ever experienced an anticlimax / spiritual 'depression' after a time of fruitful Gospel ministry? What do we need to remember in those times?
- 5. Are illnesses the result of demonic influence? Then? Now?

- 6. What might moving a mountain (v20) look like in your life?
